The application for a pardon is free, a lawyer is not necessary, and over 80% of the people going before the PA Board of Pardons are actually ending up with a pardon! Over a ten-year period, pardons brought over \$16.5 million dollars in higher wages into communities all across the state.

If you would like one-on-one assistance, there will be Pardon Hub Coaches available throughout Beaver County "Pardon Hubs" that can provide you with a Pardon Project Volunteer.
